Maryland **Universal Onboarding.**

What is Maryland Universal Onboarding?

The Maryland Nursing Workforce Center (MNWC) created Universal Onboarding (UO). UO is designed to standardize hospital orientation education for pre-licensure nursing students across Maryland hospitals. UO modules replace some SiTEL requirements.

Who is eligible to take UO modules?

UO is for pre-licensure nursing students only. Other student groups and all instructors must take all required SiTELS.

What do I need to do if I plan to participate UO?

Students participating in UO must provide proof of UO completion that includes their name and date of completion (within 12 months).

Students who provide proof of UO are exempt from the MedStar FY24 Annual Education Bundle and the COVID/PPE SiTELS. Students who take UO must still complete the annual Confidentiality Agreement in SiTEL, and any other entity additional SiTELS which may be required depending on placement location.

How do I complete Maryland Universal Onboarding?

If your school participates in UO, they will provide you with instructions.

What if I am not eligible to take UO modules?

If you are not a pre-licensure nursing student, are a non-MedStar employed instructor, or your school does not participate in Maryland Universal Onboarding, you must take required SiTELS.
