Acceptable Documents for Proof of United States Citizenship or Lawful Permanent Residence

The Women's Board Scholarship Application Process

Please submit a copy of one of the following:

- Official Birth Certificate issued by a U.S. state, jurisdiction or territory (Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands, Northern Mariana Islands, American Samoa, Swain's Island, Guam)
- U.S. Government-issued Certified Birth Certificate
- U.S. Certificate of Birth Abroad (DS-1350 or FS-545)
- Report of Birth Abroad of a Citizen of the U.S. (FS-240)
- Valid, unexpired U.S. Passport
- Valid, unexpired Maryland Driver's License with star (for proof of US citizenship only)
- Certificate of Citizenship (N560 or N561)
- Certificate of Naturalization (N550, N570 or N578)
- U.S. Citizen Identification Card (I-197, I-179)
- Green Card (officially known as Permanent Resident Card)
 - Conditional Green Cards, which expire in two years and are not renewable, will not be accepted.
