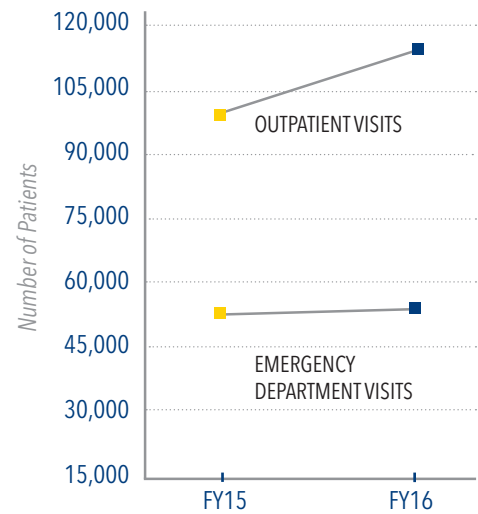
AMBULATORY SURGERY CASES

PATIENT & STAFF SAFETY

Ergonomic Wheelchairs Designed by Michael Graves (\$2,700 each)

- ▶ Contoured seat for maximum comfort
- ▶ Easy-fold armrests remain attached
- ▶ Spring-loaded, flip-up footrests remain in an upright position to reduce trip hazards transporting patients easier.

Ergonomic Stretchers Designed by Michael Graves (\$16,000 each)

- ▶ Motorized drive eliminates pushing
- ▶ Big wheels that reduce push force
- ▶ Convenient, electric lift to efficiently and safely move patients

Hoyer Lifts (\$6,760 each)

- ▶ Used to safely weigh patients who are unable to stand on a regular scale
- ▶ Allows Emergency Department to weigh potential stroke patients in a very timely way as needed to administer certain weight based medications
- ▶ Aids staff in weighing bariatric patients, keeping both patient and staff member safe

CANCER TREATMENT

Chemo Treatment and Infusion Chairs (\$10,800 each)

- ▶ Provides patients greater relaxation and comfort during long treatments
- ▶ Recliners eliminate stress points and minimize fatigue from sitting for long periods of time

STAFF & COMMUNITY EDUCATION

SimMan 3G (\$113,000)

- ▶ Advanced patient simulator displays neurological and physiological symptoms
- ▶ Simple to operate and features innovative technology such as automatic drug recognition
- ▶ Delivers realistic training experience
- ▶ Can be used beyond classroom to provide benefit in actual patient care environment
- ▶ Improves patient satisfaction and comfort

MATERNAL & NEWBORN CARE

Handheld Hearing Screeners (\$13,350 each)

- ▶ Helps detect possible hearing loss in the first days of a baby's life, which is very difficult to determine later without newborn hearing screening
- ▶ Aides in treatment and early intervention of infant hearing loss and learning important communication skills
- ▶ 1 to 3 of every 1,000 babies are born with some hearing loss
- ▶ About half of the children with hearing loss have no risk factors

THE PATIENT EXPERIENCE

Atrium (Donations of \$100 or more will be recognized on a permanent wall plaque)

- ▶ Offers hospital visitors, associates/medical staff and the community a place to gather
- ▶ Expanded occupancy with privacy room divider
- ▶ Revitalized interior look and design
- ▶ New and additional furniture and lighting
- ▶ Wall display featuring local artwork

AccuVein Infrared Light Vein Finder (\$4,800 each)

- ▶ Helps to locate veins by using infrared light to project a map of the veins on the skin
- ▶ Projects map by detecting differences in hemoglobin concentration between veins and surrounding tissue
- ▶ Increases a first stick success rate by 3.5x
- ▶ Reduces pain by 59 percent in pediatric patients

Electronic Patient Tracking System (\$82,000)

- ▶ Helps manage patient handoffs between departments
- ▶ Results in shorter wait times
- ▶ Manages room usage
- ▶ Improves the patient flow process by allowing hospitals to track times of functions or tasks
