<p>PATIENT AND STAFF SAFETY</p> <p>Ergonomic Wheelchairs, designed by Michael Graves, have a seat contoured for maximum comfort. Armrests fold back easily and are not removable so they never get lost. Spring-loaded, flip-up footrests remain in an upright position to reduce trip hazards. Attached IV poles make transporting patients easier. And bigger wheels mean better maneuverability, even for bariatric patients.</p>	Multiple Departments	\$2,700 Each Quantity Desired: 12
<p>Ergonomic Stretchers, also designed by Michael Graves, have a motorized drive that eliminates pushing. Big wheels on the stretchers also reduce push force. They have a convenient electric lift for efficiently and safely moving patients.</p>	Multiple Departments	\$16,000 Each Quantity Desired: 7
<p>Hoyer Lifts are assistive devices designed for the safe handling of patients and weighing of patients.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allows Emergency Department to weigh potential Stroke Patients in a very timely way. The medication to reverse the side effects of stroke is weight based and needs to be given in a very short window of time. • Used for patients who are unable to stand on a regular scale • Aids staff in weighing bariatric patients keeping both patient and staff member safe 	Emergency Department	\$6,760 Each Quantity Desired: 1
<p>IMPROVING THE PATIENT EXPERIENCE</p> <p>Specialized vein finders project an infrared light on skin and a map of the veins on the skin above them by detecting the difference in hemoglobin concentration between veins and the surrounding tissue.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increases a first stick success rate by 3.5x • Reduces pain by 59 percent in pediatric patients • Improves patient satisfaction and comfort 	Multiple Departments	\$4,800 Each Quantity Desired: 8
<p>A patient tracking system helps manage the patient flow process. <p>MATERNAL AND NEWBORN CARE</p> <p>The use of handheld hearing screeners can detect possible hearing loss in the first days of a baby's life. Once confirmed, treatment and early intervention can help with hearing loss and learning important communication skills.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 to 3 of every 1,000 babies are born with some hearing loss • Without newborn hearing screening, it is difficult to detect hearing loss in the first months and years of life • About half of the children with hearing loss have no risk factors 	<p>Women's Health & Family Birthing Center</p>	<p><i>\$13,350 Each</i> <i>Quantity Desired: 1</i></p>
<p>CANCER TREATMENT</p> <p>Chemo treatment and infusion chairs provide patients greater relaxation and comfort during long treatments such as chemotherapy and infusion therapy.
