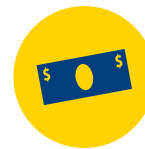

MedStar Health

Purchased 20 Transcutaneous Electrical Nerve Stimulation (TENS) System units with 100 leads and 100 electrode packs for the pain management pilot project



MedStar Institute for Innovation

Helped create the MedStar Innovation & Design Lab (MIND Lab)



MedStar Ambulatory Services

Supported the waiting room play center and purchased clinical therapy equipment for pediatric rehabilitation patients in Bel Air



MedStar SiTEL

Benefited the development of the e-learning curriculum and accredited modules for the MedStar International Training Center for Bloodless Medicine and Surgery



MedStar Health Institute for Quality and Safety

Supported the creation of a Fellowship Research position to focus of quality and safety research initiatives
