



## Profile Configuration – Baseline Pre-configuration for Clinical Keywords

1. Create your user account (reference the email you received from [support@kyruus.com](mailto:support@kyruus.com))
2. Navigate to login.kyruus.com and enter email & password
3. Once logged-in, you will be brought to the page with all template specialties. To begin, in the top right search bar begin searching for the specialty/subspecialty you wish to review

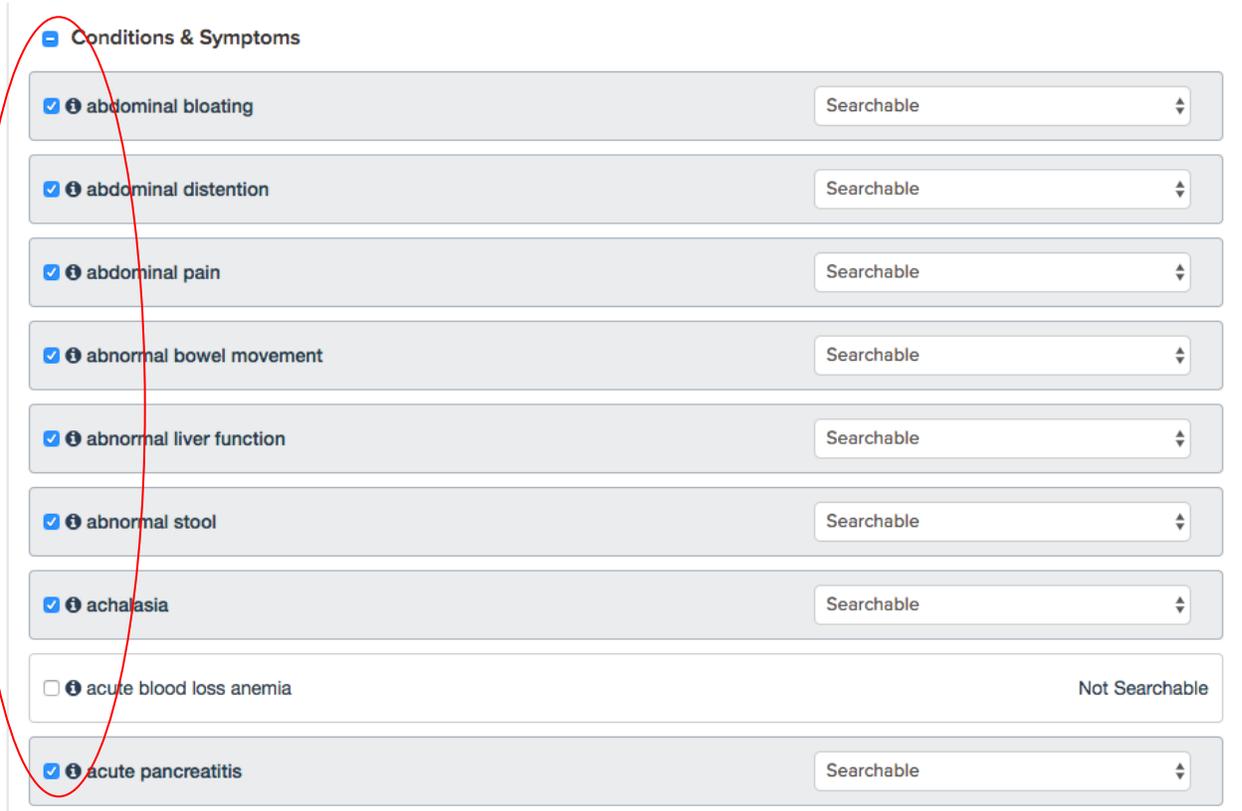

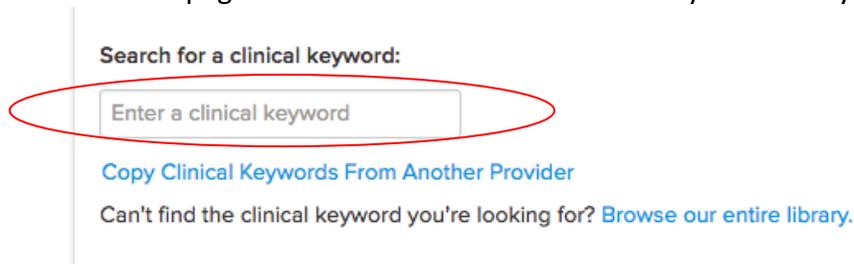

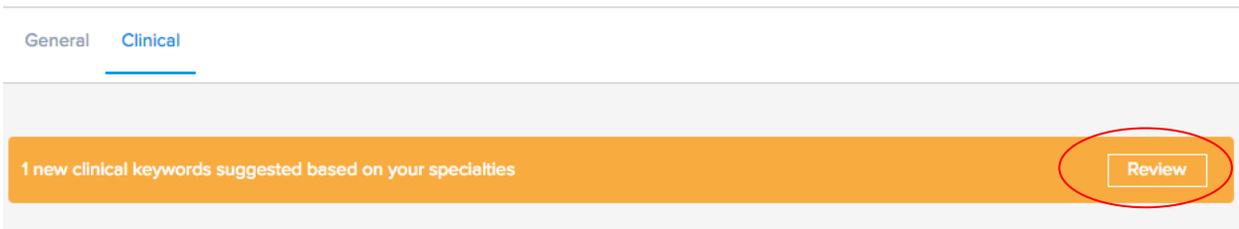
### Suggested Clinical Keyword

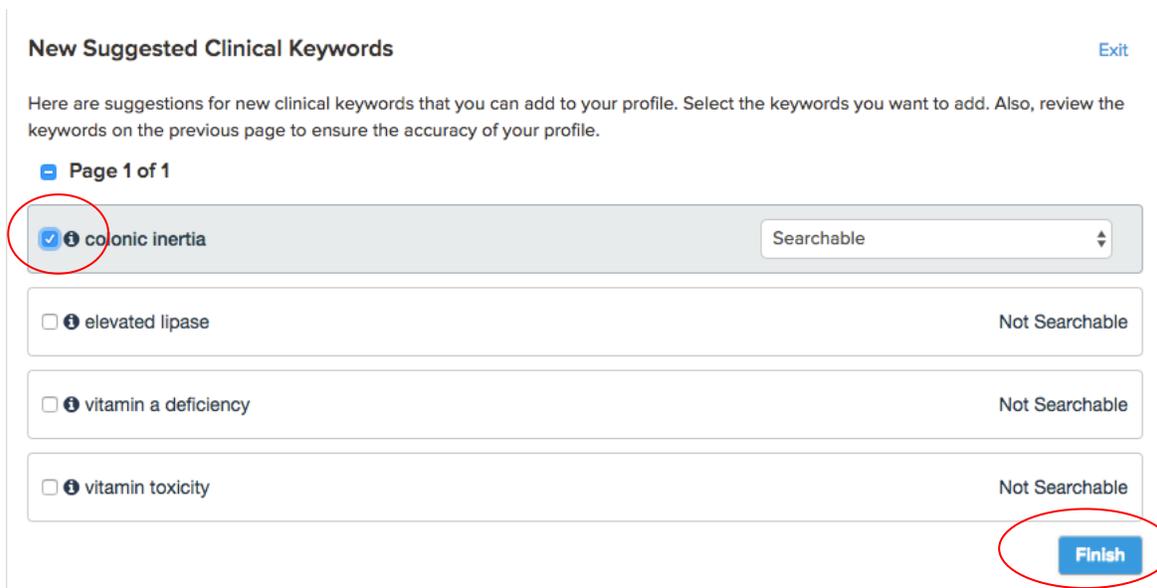
1. Click “Review”
