

Transport DC

- All metroAccess DC residents may participate
- Travel to any location within the city for \$5
- Wheelchair accessible vehicles upon request
- Up to 2 companions may ride at no additional cost
- Service is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- Schedule your ride: 1-844-322-7732 at least 1 hour prior to pick-up time

Seabury Connector

- Available to Washington, D.C. residents, age 60 and older
- There is no charge to ride with the Seabury Connector, but enrollment is required
- Schedule a ride 3 days in advance and no later than 1pm the day before a ride is needed 202-727-7771
- Operates Monday-Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Seabury Connector also offers ConnectorCard, a service of Seabury's Call 'N' Ride program that provides subsidized transportation funds for eligible residents of the District of Columbia.

Medical Transportation Management

- Available to eligible Medicaid beneficiaries
- Responsible for all non-emergency medical transportation within the Washington DC metropolitan area, including the city of Washington DC, the suburbs of Montgomery and Prince Georges County in Maryland, and Northern Virginia counties of Fairfax, Arlington and the City of Alexandria.
- Schedule 3 days before an appointment: 1-866-796-0601

Call-A-Bus (Prince George's County)

- Free and available to all residents of Prince George's County who are not served by or cannot use existing bus or rail services
- Schedule your ride at least 2 days in advance: 301-336-1402

Services are provided Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Call-A-Cab (Prince George's County)

- Transportation assistance program providing mobility at a 50% reduced rate for County seniors (age 60+) and/or County persons with disabilities
- Call 301-883-5656 for applications

Medical Assistance Transportation Program (Medicaid)—PG County

- Non-Emergency Transportation services are available for residents who have no other means of getting to their medical appointments. Services are provided for Prince George's County residents that have valid Medical Assistance cards.



Medical Assistance Transportation Program (continued)

- There is no fee for service. Non-emergency transportation services must be scheduled a minimum of 24 hours in advance: 301-856-9555

MTA Mobility/Paratransit Program (Baltimore City and Anne Arundel and Baltimore counties)

- Mobility/Paratransit service is for citizens who are functionally unable to use Local Bus, Metro/Subway or Light Rail service

- Available on the same days and during the same hours as any Local Bus, Light Rail or Metro/Subway 365 days a year.
- Call Mobility Certification office: 410-764-8181 to request an application, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Reservations are accepted during normal business hours seven days a week: 410-764-8181
- One way fare is \$1.90 for eligible riders and their guests.
