- Uribel (Methenamine/Sodium Phosphate Monobasic/Phenyl Salicylate /Methylene Blue/Hyoscyamine Sulfate)
- Xofluza (baloxavir maroxil)

### **Additions with Prior Authorization:\***

- Xospata (gilteritinib)
- Talzenna (talazoparib)
- Vitrakvi (larotrectinib)
- Lorbrena (lorlatinib)

### **Managed Drug Limitations & Step Therapy\*\***

The quantity limit on the following medications will be decreased from 180 to 60 pills per 23 days:

- Butalbital/acetaminophen/caffeine/codeine
- Butalbital/aspirin/caffeine/codeine
- Codeine sulfate tabs
- Codeine/acetaminophen

The quantity limit on the following medication increased from 3 to 12 fills per 365 days:

- ELLA (ulipristal acetate) emergency contraception
- Levonorgestrel emergency contraception
